Boot Reminder

We want to remind all 7th-12th graders and their parents that boots are **not part of the uniform**. Students can wear boots on their way to school if they chose, but they must change into the uniform shoes once they are here in order to be in full uniform. This rule applies to the entire academic day including lunch and any Ambassador activities that require full uniform dress. Elementary students are allowed to wear plain brown or black boots with low heels during the months of October-March. Elementary students that choose to wear plain brown or black boots are encouraged to bring PE shoes on PE days.

You will then enter your student's four-digit school id and their date of birth. This will allow you to have a parent log in with options to view missing work, see final grades, and even set up notifications when your student is missing work. Parents of students in 9th-12th grade should also verify that their student passed each class. An F or NG mark indicates they did not pass and did not receive credit in that course.
