#### **\*CARPOOL REMINDER\***

We have been having an extreme amount of parents not following Carpool expectations. Here's another reminder of how it works:

1. The lane closest to the curb or the outside lane, is only for kindergarten parents and stops at the Elementary crosswalk.
2. The inside lane is for all other students and begins after the Elementary crosswalk.
3. The middle lane is an EXIT ONLY lane. You may not get to the curb to pick up your child from the middle lane. You may park and walk across the crosswalk to pick up your children or drop things off. Please, note that children are not allowed to cross without a parent.

We also ask that parents not use the gas station as a pick up spot during afternoon carpool. Our staff is unable to provide safety support to students when they meet parents at an off campus location.
