West Valley - Food Service Employee

Under the supervision of the food services manager/program manager and school director, the School Food Service Employee receives food items and distributes meals to classrooms and/or students. Assists parents with Free/Reduced Lunch Applications and ordering meals.

Accurately completes and submits all required food service reports. Operates and cleans facility and equipment. Follows Utah State safety standards for food preparation, safety, storage and disposal. Follows National School Lunch Program, National School Breakfast Program, Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program, After School Snack Program guidelines. Follows all APA Staff policies. May complete other campus food service staff duties as needed. School Food Service employees will not work more than 29 hours per week unless additional hours are approved and included in yearly LOU.
