Fire Evacuation

Our students and staff are amazing! As many of you are aware, earlier this week an exhaust fan in the elementary bathroom overheated and caught on fire. We are grateful for observant students and staff who acted quickly and calmly in this situation. Our fantastic operations team worked together and staff member, Airon Buck, quickly put out the fire with an extinguisher. The smoke tripped the fire alarm and sent an alert to our alarm company as well as the fire department. Though the fire was extinguished quickly, the smoke had spread enough that the fire department set up a series of fans to move the smoke outside until it was safe for everyone to reenter. The damage was fortunately very minimal. It was an absolutely beautiful day to be outside as we waited for the all clear from our first responders. We want to thank the fire fighters, WVC police department and all of our community members who helped ensure our safety this week. We are also grateful for the opportunities we have had earlier in the year to practice evacuating the building, as students and staff were able to remain calm and quickly exit the building. Parents of 11th Graders

All of our students took the ACT college entrance exam in early March. But all major colleges in Utah also accept the SAT test for college entrance. Although it's less popular in Utah, it is still an allowable option. This might be a good choice for your student. Waivers are available for low-income students, the questions are worded slightly differently, they might get a higher score, and if a student uses a low-income voucher to pay for this test it also acts as an application fee waiver for college this coming December (only applicable for certain institutions).
