We want to thank and express our support to all those families that have been participaring of the **Request to Test**. Since last week, a lot of students, parents and staff members have requested to get tested at their school campus, which have helped us to get earlier detection of the virus and take the apropiated measures to reduce the spread. If you are interested, you can request a test for your students or yourself by going to our website on the front page, in the blue bar (far right) click on "COVID19 Info"!t will take you to a page where you will find instructions on how to request a rapid test. We encourage all families to go to testapa.com and register your children so we can test them. Additionally, KN95 masks were delivered by the state of Utah for every student at our campus, which are NOT MANDATORY TO WEAR. Providing each student with a mask allows each family the option to decide what's best for their children. Finally, in response to increasing illness in general, we have instituted temperature checks in our elementary schools. These are very quick and easy to do and we hope to identify students that are ill before exposing other children to common viruses that are normally transmitted in a school. We appreciate all of our families and wish you the very best of health during this challenging time.

These past 2 weeks we've had staff out sick themselves and/or out with a sick child. This has told us we need at least 4 more staff working the shift 8am-3pm.

The discount code they will use is APAcomp.


Tickets are obtained by visiting our website draperphilharmonic.org and clicking on the "Get Tickets" button under the "Concerts" link and choosing your preferred venue.
