

Welcome to the month of November where the weather is cool and the leaves are falling from the trees. This also means that we are **ONE MONTH AWAY FROM OUR WINTER CONCERT**. Students were sent home a flier for our Winter Concert which also includes a QR code to scan to reserve your tickets for the concert on Friday, December 6th at 6 p.m. Our students will proudly present "Sounds of the Holidays" and tickets are limited. There will not be assigned seats but **everyone wanting to attend (NOT including our Sistema students who are performing) will be required to have a ticket which needs to be reserved ahead of time.** Tickets are free - please note we *do not recommend* having babies or younger children (under 5 years old) attend the concert as it is a longer one that we will also be live-streaming.
